



## **IUTOX Lifetime Achievement Award**

The IUTOX Lifetime Achievement Award honors a distinguished scientist who has made lasting contributions to toxicology in countries where toxicology is under-represented. This is a new award that will be conferred on a recipient for the first time during the opening ceremony at the 10<sup>th</sup> Congress of Toxicology in Developing Countries in Belgrade, Serbia (April 2018). The award will be a regular feature of future CTDC meetings.

### **IUTOX Lifetime Achievement Award Winner Receives:**

- \$1,000 (USD)
- Plaque

### **Rules:**

- Only the official leadership of an IUTOX member society may nominate candidates for the award.
- IUTOX will issue a call for nominations 270 days before the CTDC meeting where the award will be presented (July 22, 2017).
- All nominations must be received by the IUTOX secretariat 180 days before the CTDC meeting where the award will be presented (October 20, 2017).
- The IUTOX Executive Committee has sole responsibility for selecting the award winner 30 days after the application deadline.

### **Nominees Must Satisfy the Following Criteria:**

- Works in the field of toxicology.
- Actively promotes the field of toxicology in developing countries.
- Demonstrates leadership in capacity building activities.
- Shows dedication to mentoring, teaching, and advancing the careers of young and mid-career scientists.
- Actively participates in IUTOX member society activities.

## **Application Process:**

IUTOX Lifetime Achievement Award nomination packages must reach IUTOX by October 20, 2017 and must include, at a minimum, the following information:

1. Nominating letters from two IUTOX member Societies;
2. A statement detailing how the nominee has promoted capacity building activities in countries where toxicology is under-represented; their dedication to mentoring, teaching, and advancing careers of young and mid-career scientists; and service to their member society
3. A current *curriculum vitae* of no more than five pages (list at a minimum their five best publications).
