




We look forward to welcoming you to the 41th EAPCCT Congress held virtually from 25th to 28th May 2021

CONGRESS PROGRAMME & THEMES

The theme for the Pre-congress on 25th May is: Fundamental and applied studies in poisoning – an overview of their role for the Clinical Toxicologist.

Many interesting moderators who are experts in the respective area provide an extensive discussion ranging from animal models to machine learning, pharmacogenomics and pharmacokinetic-dynamic modelling, mitochondrial

mechanisms and diagnostic methods with their applications in toxicology, up to big data analysis to find individual differences in toxicology.

The themes for the main congress, 26th-28th May are:

- Coronavirus-19 and toxicology
- Alcohol as a co-ingestant
- Investigation and management of caustic ingestions
- Toxicology 2.0: new tools for data collection, surveillance and education in poisoning
- Drug Formulation and its importance in the poisoned patient
